



The Ocean City-Wright Fire Control District is currently accepting applications for the position of full-time firefighter.

The primary function of an employee in this class is to protect the community from emergency situations, including medical, fire, hazardous material exposure and natural and manmade disasters, and to promote an environment of public safety within the District. The firefighter has responsibility for the proper maintenance and operation of apparatus and equipment. An employee in this classification performs the duties of other employees in the Department when so assigned.

The employee is subject to adverse weather conditions, exposure to hazardous chemicals and/or materials, extreme heat, and/or potential personal danger in this work environment.

Candidates must have an acceptable driving record. The candidate must also pass a drug screen, medical examination, criminal background check and meet all other pre-employment requirements. The District will notify each candidate of a testing date & other information.
